Subject City Council Order #26 of Dec. 12, 1988 "Resident Parking on River St."

The west side of River Street between Putnam Avenue and Blackstone Street is zoned for business and therefore cannot qualify for resident parking. Also, there is no parking allowed along side of playgrounds due to children playing and sledding on the slopes of this park. To allow parking would obstruct the view of drivers and increase the danger of children getting hurt.

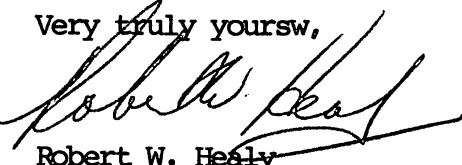
