
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to convey to the License Commission that it is the sense of this City Council that the request of the Harvard University School of Design for a Beer and Wine License be denied due to the fact that the area in which the school is located is already saturated with liquor and drinking establishments; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the License Commission to determine the number of Liquor Licenses already issued to both Harvard University and Massachusetts Institute of Technology; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the City Solicitor to determine whether or not these licenses are covered by the City Ordinances of Cambridge or the Statutes of the Commonwealth; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Board of Assessors to determine whether or not the residences occupied by the Presidents of Harvard University and Massachusetts Institute of Technology are currently on the real estate tax rolls and if not to conduct appraisals of these homes to determine whether a tax bill should be sent on advice of the City Solicitor; and further if the City Solicitor so determines then tax bills should be sent immediately to each of the universities and if said bills are not promptly paid that the City Solicitor be instructed to collect the tax bills outstanding; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to arrange a pow-wow with the officials of Harvard University, Massachusetts Institute of Technology and this City Council to discuss our feelings and to enlighten them as to what is

on our minds and to further discuss their responsibilities to the citizens of Cambridge, particularly in light of the constraints imposed on the City Government as a result of Proposition 2½.
