It is part of the Cambridge Hackney Carriage Rules and Regulations that a licensed Cambridge Taxicab driver may not seek or carry a hackney license in another community.

This is due to the fact that all surrounding communities have agreed and have imposed this rule. The purpose of this rule is to prevent competition within communities and to allow enough jobs for drivers within each city or town since driver's jobs are limited.
