LICENSE COMMISSION

September 8, 1976

To The Honorable, The City Council:

It has been brought to the attention of the License Commission by owners of Cambridge Taxis that the procedure to mechanically readjust taxi meters to conform with the increase in taxifares in accordance with the provisions of the Ordinance of the City Council has met with difficulty. Accordingly, we are informed that all meters will not be corrected to meet the date of Sept. 15, 1976 when the increased fares was to be effective.

The difficulty arises from the fact that the re-adjustment requires an additional gear or in some cases a new meter. Taxi owners allege that because of the number of meters involved it will be impossible to conform with the provisions of the September 15, 1976 deadline since the concerns that do this work are deluged with orders.

An extension of the deadline is therefore requested by the taxi people.
