

The funding status for the proposed East Cambridge parking garage was raised at a recent meeting of East Cambridge Community groups and organizations. The community is anxious to see construction of the parking garage move ahead as quickly as possible due to its link to the renovation of the Bulfinch Courthouse. We understand that a bill is currently pending before the House Ways and Means Committee which, if approved, would authorize additional funding for parking garage construction in Commercial Area Revitalization Districts.
