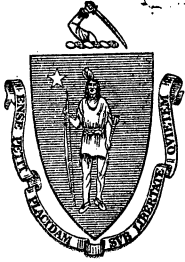

Investigation by the Department upon its own motion as to the propriety of the rates and charges for gas in certain schedules filed with the Department on December 17, 1947 to become effective January 1, 1948 by Cambridge Gas Light Company.

After due notice, public hearings were held on the above entitled investigation on January 15, and February 9, 1948.

Subsequent to the hearings, the company under date of October 19, 1948 withdrew the rates under investigation by the Department. This action by the company has the effect of continuing in effect indefinitely the presently existing rates, pending further order of the Department. It does not terminate our investigation of the customers' complaint under D.P.U. 8049, which includes an investigation of existing rates, and which is still in progress and will be prosecuted as diligently as conditions permit. It seems, therefore, proper for the Department to close the proceedings investigating the rates filed December 17, 1947.

Accordingly, after due notice, public hearing, investigation and consideration, it is

ORDERED: That the Department's investigation in D.P.U. 8015 be and the same is hereby terminated and closed.
