WHEREAS: Joseph married the late Louise Dell'Olio; and their marriage was blessed with their daughters Ann and Emily, and, in turn, with their grandsons Alex, Spencer and Justin; and

WHEREAS: Joseph served his country with courage and valor in World War II; he was a Staff Sergeant and the Gunner for a B 24 Liberator Bomber; he was shot down over Europe in 1944 and held by the Germans as a prisoner of war; and

WHEREAS: Joseph is a retired carpenter of Local 67; and

WHEREAS: His joy in life is his grandchildren; and

WHEREAS: Joseph was honored by the East Cambridge Little League for the many hours he has devoted to assisting Cambridge youth in baseball; and

WHEREAS: Joseph has worked long and hard for much needed safety precautions at the corner of Plymouth and Berkshire Streets; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record dedicating the corner of Plymouth Street and Berkshire Street in honor of Joseph "Buddy" Camara and in recognition of his service to his country and his community; and be it further
