The Public Aid Committee reports, pursuant to the rules of the City Council, that it has obtained from the Secretary of the Board of Public Welfare and the W.P.A. Sponsor monthly reports for the month of March.

The Board of Public Welfare reports on Old Age Assistance cases, one hundred eighty-seven (187) more than at the end of February; and that on General Relief and Aid to Dependent Children sixty-six (66) cases less than at the end of February. These classes of cases cost the city \$118,780.16 during the month of March, a decrease of \$3,841.09 as against the month of February.

The Sponsor's Agent reports one thousand and ten persons employed during the month of March on W.P.A. Projects at a cost of \$11,034.87 to the city, a decrease of \$5,266.64 as against the month of February; and a cost of \$95,623.18 to the Federal Government, a decrease of \$3,915.58 as against the month of February.
