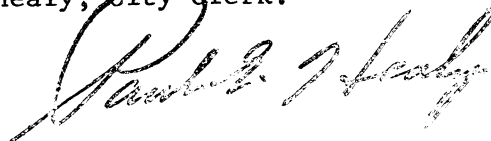

Attached please find for your review and action an order requesting the acceptance and appropriation of a grant in the amount of \$13,496 from the Executive Office of Communities and Development to the Department of Human Service Programs Grant Fund. This appropriation will be distributed as follows: Salaries and Wages, \$12,746, and Other Ordinary Maintenance, \$750.
