Dear Cambridge City Council Members:

At the September 16, 1991 public meeting of the Cambridge City Council, each of you city councilors and your chair, the mayor, received two (2) Complaints against your employee, City Manager, Robert Healy, (Communications #32 and #34) and his employee Ned Casey for refusing to perform their duties as described in the two (2) communications.

As you all are aware, your chair, the Mayor, who you pay to chair the council's city manager performance review board, did manipulate you into allowing her to refuse to earn the money you pay her, when she, quite cleverly, shifted my Complaints from her review board to the council's cable committee, which is not empowered by you, the members of the city council, or the cambridge city charter, to review the performance of the city manager or his employees.

Further, as quiet as it has been kept by the cable committee chair and its member, the vice mayor, neither have ever been permitted by the city council rules to hold position's on the council's cable committee or to be involved in my complaints against cambridge community television because both have had financial interest in cambridge community television.

Further, because section 18 of the State Cable Television Act provides for jail and financial penalties for anyone who aids and abets the violations of the state Cable Television Act, I urge the cable committee chair and the vice-mayor to return my Complaints, (Communications #32 and #34) back to the mayor and her city manager performance review board or that the rest of you city councilors order them to do so, for speedy disposition by the performance review board.
