COUNCILLOR D. SULLIVAN

- WHEREAS: Inman Square, one of the traditional neighborhood retail centers which have characterized Cambridge, has begun a commercial revitalization in recent years; and
- WHEREAS: The city has attempted to further the improvement of this area by such steps as acquisition of a municipal parking lot and the recent eminent domain taking for Inman Square Park; and
- WHEREAS: The recent destruction by fire of the building housing Legal Sea Foods, one of the businesses most responsible for recent improvements, threatens to undermine the progress which the area has made; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That this City Council declares its support for the rebuilding of the full Legal Sea Foods Restaurant in Inman Square, and offers the good offices of the city in urging this establishment to continue there; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to take whatever steps he considers useful, including appropriate policy directives to the Community Development Department and other city agencies, to retain the entire Legal Sea Foods operation in Inman Square.
