VICE MAYOR REEVES

WHEREAS: Residents of all Cambridge neighborhoods have the right to adequately maintained sewers; and

WHEREAS: Residents of Cherry Street and neighboring streets have complained about persistent problems with the sewer system in their neighborhood, including foul odors and sewer overflow into their basements during rainy weather; and

WHEREAS: Many of these problems have persisted for over two years, causing discomfort from the odors and damage to personal property due to the flooding; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to investigate the matter of sewer odors and flooding of basements in the Cherry Street area, and report back to this City Council within one week with a proposed solution, and in the course of this investigation the City Manager is further requested to consult with Mr. Edward S. Roachford of 56 Cherry Street, Cambridge.
