- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Dr. Marvin Herbert, former Chief of Orthopedics at the Cambridge Hospital; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Herbert was born in Everett, graduated from Boston Latin School, Harvard College in 1953 and Tufts Medical School in 1957 serving as an intern at the New England Medical Center and his surgical residency at the Cambridge Hospital; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Herbert later became an orthopedic fellow at Boston City Hospital and served his orthopedic residency at Lahey Clinic, Shriners Hospital for Crippled Children and Boston City Hospital; and
- WHEREAS: Dr. Herbert was affectionately known as "Flash" because of his skill and expert surgical speed, a skill which was admired by his medical colleagues; and
- WHEREAS: The passing of Dr. Herbert leaves a tremendous void in the lives of his family and friends who have loved and admired him over the years; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our deepest sympathy of Mrs. Florence Herbert and family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Herbert on behalf of the entire City Council.
