## WHEREAS:-

The probable result of the Daggett Trust building upon the land they are now offering to purchase would be that the present incinerator building would be declared a menace to their product. It is therefore

## ORDERED:-

That His Honor the Mayor be and hereby is requested to enter into negotiations with the said Daggett Trust with a view of interesting them in the purchase of the whole plot including the incinerator building as it now stands, and to report the result of such negotiations to the City Council.
