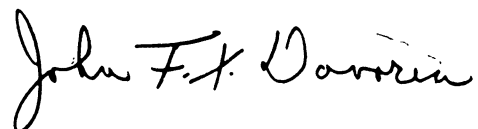

1. The name by which the corporation shall be known is:

The Lalit Center of Indian Music and Dance, Inc.

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

To cultivate, promote, foster, sponsor and develop among its members and the general public the appreciation, understanding, taste and love of the music of India; to create a center for the advancement of such purposes; to secure the interest of patrons of these arts; the giving of concerts, recitals and instruction and the dissemination of information pertaining to the culture of India and her people, her religion, history, language and philosophy by lectures, publications, film or otherwise; the offering and sponsoring of exchange programs and visits with persons from India and the offering of tours to India; the importation of musical instruments, recordings, sheet music and books; all for no pecuniary gain; to lease, buy, sell, use and hold all types of property, by grant, gift, purchase, devise or bequest, as may be necessary or convenient, in connection with the purposes of this corporation; to carry on any other activities in order to achieve the purposes of this corporation and the doing of any and all things necessary or incident thereto.

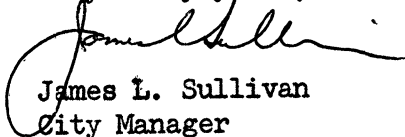
