COUNCILLOR GRAHAM

WHEREAS: The voters of the Commonwealth have mandated that Proposition 2 1/2 shall become the law in this state; and

WHEREAS: This vote placed the City Council in the position of having to make difficult choices in terms of seeking acceptable ways of living within these newly imposed fiscal restrictions; and

WHEREAS: It is imperative that the City Council begin immediately to analyze the impacts of this legislation and figure out a way to observe it without cutting essential services to our citizens; therefore be it

ORDERED: That the chairman of the City Council Finance Committee be requested to convene a meeting of that committee at the earliest possible date so that we can begin at once to undertake a detailed analysis of expenditures and revenues and forge a sensible solution to the dilemmas which are posed by passage of Question 2.
