Investigation by the Department upon its own motion as to the propriety of the rates and charges stated in the complete revision of Section 2 M.D.P.U. No. 6 and revised sheets A-2; A-2A; AA2; AA-2A; AA-2B; A-3; B-3; D-3A; G-2; M-1; of Section 3 to M.D.P.U. No. 6 and Sheet 5 of Section 4 to M.D.P.U. No. 6 filed November 19, 1951 to become effective December 20, 1951 by New England Telephone and Telegraph Company.

The New England Telephone and Telegraph Company having filed with the Department the tariff revision identified above, it is

ORDERED: That the operation of the rates and charges stated therein be suspended and the use thereof deferred until October 20, 1952 unless otherwise ordered by the Department.

FURTHER ORDERED: That a public hearing shall be held as to the propriety of the rates and charges stated therein on Monday, December 17, 1951 at 10:15 o'clock in the forenoon at the Department's hearing room, 166 State House, Boston, Massachusetts.

FURTHER ORDERED: That a copy of this order be filed with the tariffs at the offices of the Department and that a copy be served forthwith upon the New England Telephone and Telegraph Company.
