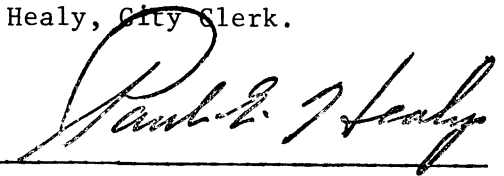
COUNCILLOR DANEHY

- WHEREAS: It is with great concern that this City Council is receiving numerous and increasing complaints relative to the operation of the Portland Stone Ware Company located at 177 Pemberton Street; and
- WHEREAS: The residents of this neighborhood have repeatedly attempted to communicate with the owners of this company in an effort to solve the problems attendant to this company's operations in the early morning hours and the lack of cooperation and general rudeness by which the neighbors have been treated; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Inspectional Services Commissioner, Fire Chief, Police Chief, Traffic and Parking Director and the City Engineer to conduct an on site inspection of the premises to determine, among other things, whether or not this company is in full compliance with all health and safety codes, city ordinances and traffic regulations as well as to make a determination of the right-of-way between the Portland Stone Ware Company and the property located at 161 Pemberton Street; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to provide this City Council with a report pursuant to this order within one week.
