Ordered, The Joint Committee on Roads and Bridges to which was referred the Petition of James S. Green, in relation to Garden Street, above the junction of Linnaean Street, with all papers on file relating to the same subject, - has considered the same and begs leave to
Report:-

That said Garden Street appears by the Records to be an ancient way, but the lines of the same have never been determined. The Committee would not recommend that any measures be taken at the present time to determine said lines, or to establish the grade of the sidewalks, but, inasmuch as the road is out of repair, would recommend that the Superintendent of Streets be instructed to put said street in order so as to be safe and convenient for public travel under the direction of the Surveyors of Highways. -
