- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Lieutenant Harold J. Travers has retired from active duty on the Cambridge Fire Department; and
- WHEREAS: Lieutenant Travers was first appointed a firefighter on February 14, 1943 at which time he was assigned to Engine 6 where he remained until July 31, 1949 when he was transferred to Ladder Company 3; and
- WHEREAS: Firefighter Travers was transferred on May 5, 1972 to the position of Aide to the Deputy Chief, a position he held until July 23, 1973 at which time he was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant; and
- WHEREAS: Lieutenant Travers had always been a dedicated firefighter throughout his 36 years in the department being specifically commended for bravery in 1944; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our sincere gratitude to Lieutenant Harold J. Travers for his dedication to duty and to further extend to him our very best wishes for a healthy and happy retirement; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Lieutenant Travers on behalf of the entire City Council.
