An Ordinance

In addition to "An Ordinance providing for the
appointment, and prescribing the duties, of City Marshal,
and establishing a City Watch".

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cam-
bridge, as follows: -

1. - So much of "an Ordinance providing for the ap-
pointment, and prescribing the duties, of City
Marshal, and establishing a City Watch", passed
on the thirtieth^{day} of June, eighteen hundred and
~~fifty one~~, as relates to the appointment and
duties of City Marshal and two Deputy Mar-
shals, is hereby repealed.
2. - The Mayor and Aldermen shall forthwith ap-
point, and shall hereafter, at the Commencement
of every Municipal year, appoint three ^{Principal} Constables,
one of whom shall reside in Ward One, one in
Ward Two, and one in Ward Three, who shall,
within their respective wards, perform all the
duties heretofore required to be performed by
the City and Deputy Marshals.
3. - All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, inconsistent
with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby
repealed.
