The Joint Standing Committee on Roads and Bridges, to which was referred the petition of William Lawrence, praying, that as an equitable settlement for the non-fulfilment of a contract made by the city, in relation to a plank sidewalk on the northerly side of Brattle Street, - a sum equal to 50 per cent of the cost of said sidewalk, viz: \$242.⁴² be refunded to the subscribers therefor, - would respectfully

Report,

The reasons upon which the petitioner bases his claim, are fully set forth in his petition now before this board. They have been fully considered by your Committee, and it is of the opinion that the repayment of the sum asked for would be an equitable adjustment of the claim.

Your Committee therefore recommends the adoption of the accompanying order authorizing the payment to the petitioner, of the sum of \$242.⁴² as prayed for, provided he shall, on the part of the aforesaid subscribers, relinquish

all claims on account of the construction of said plank walk, and surrender the material to the city.
