RESOLVED:

That the City Council of Cambridge, Massachusetts, U.S.A., hereby resolves to request the appropriate official of Taiwan to make public the reasons for the arrest of Liu Feng-sung, and to advise whether the right of this person is being observed under the United Nations Universal Declaration of Human Rights. As elected governmental officials in a democratic society, the Cambridge City Councillors wish to say to Taiwan officials that governmental service should never result in the violation of a person's liberty, and further that disregard of the personal rights of members of a political opposition creates a destabilizing force in the world.
