Mr. Wuenschel became Executive Director of the Cambridge Housing Authority in 1978 after serving for three years as director of its development, modernization, management and leasing activities. As director, he led the authority in its role as founder, in 1981, of the Council of Large Public Housing Authorities (CLPHA). He became the first President of CLPHA, an office he held for six years, during which time CLPHA became a well-established national representative of housing authority interests.

In Cambridge, Mr. Wuenschel is probably best known for his work in the reconstruction of the city's aging public housing stock. The authority received several state and national awards for various redesign and reconstruction efforts. At the same time the Cambridge Housing Authority has been repeatedly recognized for its superior work in providing services to its residents.

A board member of Citizens Housing and Planning Association of Greater Boston (CHAPA), Mr. Wuenschel served on HUD's Occupancy Task Force in 1994 and was acknowledged in 1995 by DMH for services to mentally ill citizens of Massachusetts.
