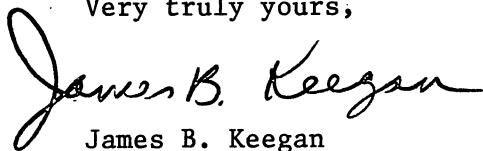

Thank you for informing us that the Cambridge City Council will be meeting with representatives of the Cambridge Rent Control Board, the Cambridge Housing Authority and Mr. Rothfuchs Monday night, December 19, 1988. Cambridgeport Savings Bank commends the time and effort expended by the City Council in attempting to remove the obstacles which have prevented Mr. Rothfuchs from converting the premises to condominiums and/or selling units to the Housing Authority.
