**AN ORDINANCE**

In amendment to an ordinance formerly entitled, "The General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge" as revised in 1972 and now designated as "The Code of the City of Cambridge."

**Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows:**

Chapter 15, Article 1 entitled: "General Provisions," Section 15.3 entitled: "Members; Organization and Administration" is hereby amended by striking out in the fourth line the following: "250 men" and substituting in place thereof the following: "350 Police Officers."
