- RESOLVED: That the members of the Cambridge City Council join with the Governor of the Commonwealth in proclaiming the week of June 7-13, 1987 as WATER CONSERVATION WEEK in Cambridge; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare two duly engrossed copies of this Resolution, one of which should be posted in the glass-enclosed announcement board in the lobby at City Hall; the other should be sent to Doctor Robert Peterkin, Superintendent of Schools, for transmittal to our city schools as a rallying point for student instruction in this most important effort.
