- WHEREAS: This disparity has resulted in the loss of a seat in the House of Representatives and the realignment of the Senatorial District as it relates to Ward 11; and
- WHEREAS: This census has a direct impact on State and local assistance provided to this City; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Chief of Police to assign the appropriate Police personnel on an overtime basis to immediately conduct a complete census for residents of the City of Cambridge to be completed by October 15th, 1987; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to provide the City Council, under separate cover, the implementation date of this order.
