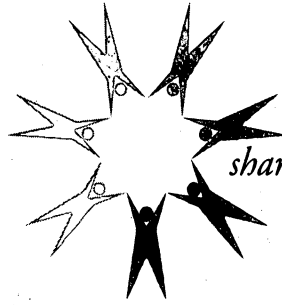

an update on arrangements for outside ice skating

In response to Council Order #6 dated 10/30/95 concerning an update on arrangements for outside ice skating, the following information is offered.

After a review of potential outdoor skating sites with the Commissioner of Public Works, it is recommended that the following sites be utilized for this program:

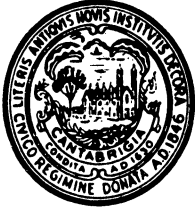
1. Glacken Field Tennis Courts
2. Riverside Press Park Basketball Courts
3. Raymond Street/Corcoran Field Basketball Courts

The rationale for selection of these sites is that they all have some form of exterior berm which will contain the ice surface and allow for maximum utilization. In addition, communication has also been established with the Electrical Department in regard to realigning of light fixtures at Glacken Field and Riverside Press Park in order to allow for skating until 9:30 p.m.

The schedule for implementation is based on weather and sub-freezing temperature factors.
