COUNCILLOR DUEHAY

- WHEREAS: Recently several serious vehicular accidents have occurred around the high school, injuring some of our students; and
- WHEREAS: Many cars, trucks and buses travel through this school area each day, often times at a high rate of speed, which prevents the driver of said vehicle to adequately stop in the case of a student crossing the street to enter or to board the school bus; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Director of Traffic and Parking to conduct a traffic circulation study of the streets around the perimeter of the high school with a view in mind of placing the appropriate traffic signs reading "Go Slow - Children Crossing" or "Go Slow - School Ahead" in and around this area.
