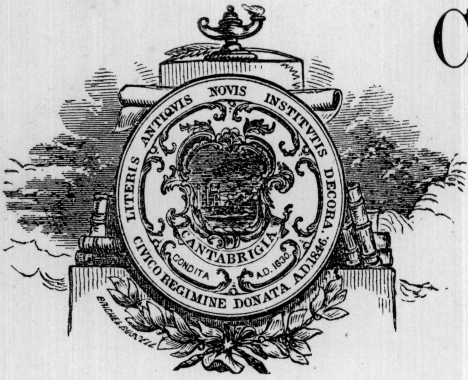

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid.
