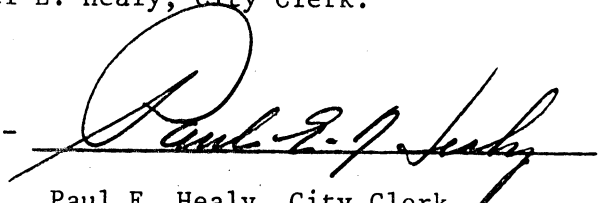
IN CITY COUNCIL
