- WHEREAS: The daffodil is one of the first flowers of the spring and therefore a symbol of hope; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Council go on record expressing its best wishes to the Cambridge Unit of the American Cancer Society for a successful Daffodil Day and extend appreciation for their efforts; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Helen Palmer with the Cambridge Unit of the American Cancer Society on behalf of the entire City Council.
