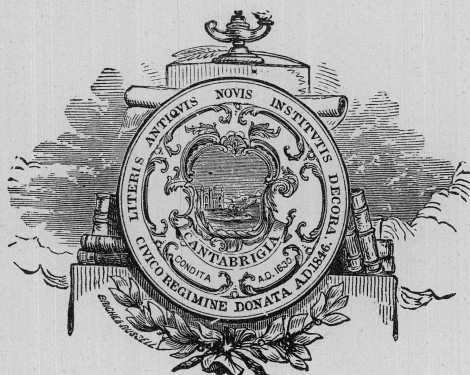

Pursuant to your instructions I have to report that the Granite Block Paving on Howard Square between Cambridge R. R. line and Boylston St petitioned for by and others, will probably require the expenditure of material and labor costing \$ 226.69, as per the following estimate, to wit:
