RESOLVED: That the City provide a legal opinion on "religious" festivals.

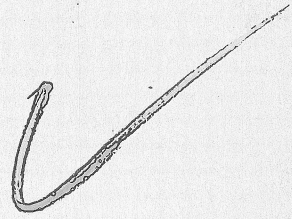
