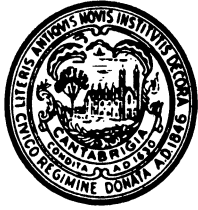

SUBJECT: Council Order #6 of 4/23/90

In response to Council Order #6, of April 23, 1990, please be advised that the City does not charge interest on water/sewer bills if they are paid by the prescribed date on the bill. The charges for interest on bills paid before the due date has never been City policy and would be illegal.

If the payment on bills is not made by the prescribed time on the bill, interest is charged back to the date of issue. This is the same action that is taken on real estate taxes and follows City ordinances and State law.
