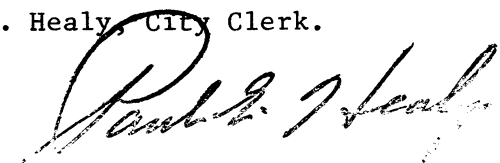

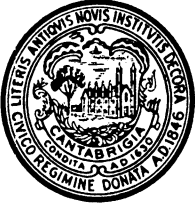

Attached please find for your review and action an order requesting the acceptance and appropriation of a grant in the amount of \$11,835 00 to the Department of Human Service Programs grant fund. This appropriation should be budgeted in Salaries and Wages (\$10,120.00) and Other Ordinary Maintenance (\$1,715.00).

This grant, from the Cambridge Housing Authority, will provide remedial on-site education programming at the Roosevelt Towers and Washington Elms/Newtowne Court family public housing developments. This program includes recruitment, diagnostic assessment, and a total of 576 instructional hours.
