VICE MAYOR WOLF

- WHEREAS: The completion of phase VI and VII of the city's sewer division project is several years off; and
- WHEREAS: The people in the Sacramento Street/Crescent Street/Carver Street/Eustis Street area, among others, have been heavily hit by several heavy rainstorms this year and in recent years, with basements flooded by several feet of water; and
- WHEREAS: Water cascading in from Somerville has contributed to the problem; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager confer with Somerville City Officials to see what can be done both in the short-run and in the long-run to reduce the flow of water into Cambridge from Somerville in the Sacramento Street area; and be it further
- ORDERED: That the City Manager report back to the Council in a timely manner the context of the discussions and the agreements that are reached, or if there is little progress, recommend what action the City Council can take to impact this situation.
