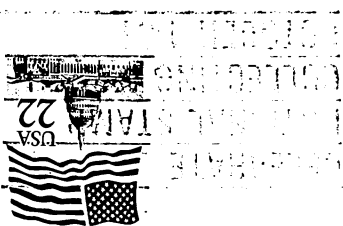

In its twelfth season, the orchestra is committed to creating a relaxed atmosphere in which its members can experience the fun and excitement of learning and playing good music. There are no auditions and no permanent part assignments. Free concerts are brought to audiences who might not otherwise hear live orchestral music. There is a yearly concert series at the Central Square Branch of the Cambridge Public Library. These programs are repeated at such sites as hospitals, elderly housing and community centers in Cambridge and the surrounding area.

The Little Orchestra of Cambridge is pleased to have Adam Grossman as its newly appointed music director and conductor. A resident of Cambridge, Adam Grossman has conducted in the Newton Public Schools, the Newton Creative Arts Program and in student recitals at Boston University, where he received a Bachelor's Degree in Music. As a free-lance violinist he performs regularly with numerous groups in the Boston area. Mr. Grossman sings with the Boston Cecilia Society and teaches at the All-Newton Music School. His *Four Hanukkah Songs* was premiered by the Newton Symphony Orchestra last December.
