WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that Police Sergeant Frank Foster has recently retired from the Police Department completing 39 years of public service, and

WHEREAS: Sgt. Foster first joined the department as a patrolman in June of 1939 and for 24 years he held various patrol assignments through the city, and

WHEREAS: In 1963 Officer Foster was promoted to the rank of Sergeant under which rank he assumed command in 1966, of all radio communication for Police, Fire, Public Works and Water Departments, and

WHEREAS: In 1973 Sgt. Foster designed and installed a new two-way radio system for the Traffic Department prior to that he had updated the radio system in the Police, Fire and Water Departments as well as designing and installing several burglar alarms in many city owned buildings reducing the level of vandalism by 90%, and

WHEREAS: Sgt. Frank Foster has exemplified the word "public servant" and has devoted 39 years of his life on behalf of this City, now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our sincere gratitude to Sgt. Foster for his outstanding dedication to this City, and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Sgt. Foster in behalf of this entire City Council.
