RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to investigate, in cooperation with the Cambridge Food Co-op, the possibility of having the above mentioned deliveries made at an hour when they are least likely to create a problem for the neighbors, such as before 9:00 a.m., and report back to this City Council within one week.
