Gentlemen;-

In the matter of the accompanying petition of the Society of St. John the Evangelist for permission to connect its premises on Memorial Drive, west of University Road, with the common sewer in said Memorial Drive, which premises have not yet been assessed for a sewer benefit, I recommend that the said Society be granted permission to connect its property with the common sewer on condition that it first pay into the City Treasury the usual sewer assessment, amounting in this case to Forty-one dollars and fifty cents (\$41.50).
