PRESS RELEASE

On Monday April 25, 1977, the State Department of Public Works will begin repairing the Beacon Street Bridge in Somerville. It is estimated that the repairs will take five (5) weeks to complete.

To provide the least inconvenience and safety to the public, we are asking motorists to avoid this area, if they possibly can. The construction will be in two phases. The east side or northbound side will be closed for repairs and when that is completed the west side or southbound side will be repaired.

During these closings, traffic will be detoured and signs indicating their direction will be posted.

Again, I am asking all motorists to avoid this area during construction so as to avoid as much traffic congestion as possible.
