- WHEREAS: Thomas attended local public schools and graduated from Boston University in 1937 and shortly thereafter opened the Thomas V. Serino Insurance Agency, which he operated in Cambridge for forty years prior to his retirement in 1982; and
- WHEREAS: Thomas was an active member of several civic and fraternal organizations, including the American Masonic Lodge in Cambridge, the Aleppo Shrine Temple in Boston, the Royal Order of Jesters and Scottish Rite and also served as a Charter Member and Past President of the Minuteman Shrine Club, as well as having served as a Town Meeting Member in Belmont and as a Member of the Cambridge Auxiliary Police; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Marion Serino and to the entire Serino family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Serino on behalf of the entire City Council.
