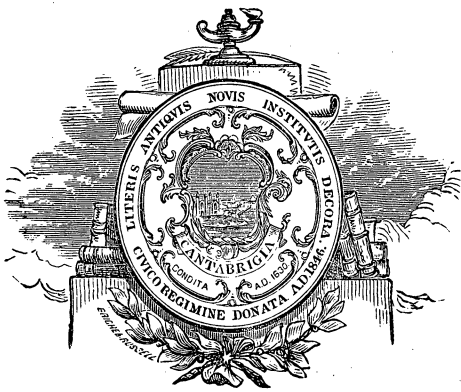




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

Dec. 24, 1883.

WHEREAS It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience
require that *Laucaster Street*, - so-called,
extending from *Walth Avenue* to *Linnean*
street,

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *thirty feet*
Linnean Street in width between *said Walth Avenue* and

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *W.A. Massey* for
Civil Engineers, and dated *Dec. 10. 1883*

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid, *the*
several owners and abutters having released the same to the
city.
