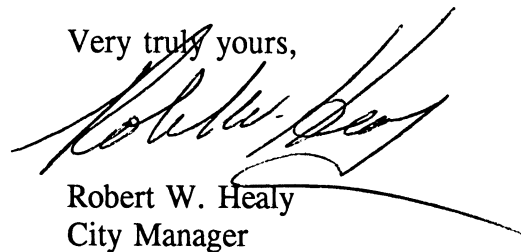

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$328,516.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salaries and Wages Account (\$212,797.00), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$107,079.00) and Travel and Training Account (\$8,640.00) from the Center for Substance Abuse Prevention of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration. This grant will be used by the Planning and Development Division which will act as the lead agency of the Cambridge Prevention Coalition. This appropriation is the second year of a three year grant. The purpose of this grant is to build a coalition of agencies, organizations and partnerships aimed at reducing alcohol, tobacco and other drug use, and to integrate substance abuse prevention into managed health care systems. Funds will be used to pay for Prevention Coalition staff, fringe benefits, program operating costs, and travel.
