- WHEREAS: The Broadway Supermarket is holding a sale during the week of April 23, 1979 to celebrate their 50 years of business; a sale which truly beats back inflation and allows its customers an opportunity to share with the owners the joy and happiness of this anniversary; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our sincere appreciation to the entire Lichter Family, owners of Broadway Supermarket, for their continuing effort to provide the Cambridge Community with quality meat and produce at reasonable prices and to further congratulate them on the occasion of their 50th Anniversary in business; and be it further
