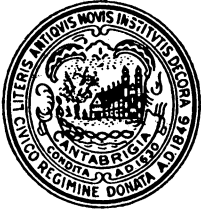

\$500.00 from Traffic Current to G-8 Radio

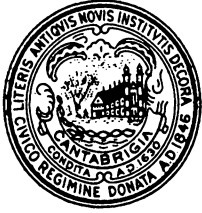


