- 1) address of proposed curb cut *7 Newton ST.*
- 2) frontage *42.15' wide*
- 3) setback *99' deep*
- 4) block & lot *Lot #109 on Plot Plan #102*
- 5) demensions of proposed driveway *8 feet wide by 30' long.*
- 6) distance from proposed driveway to any surrounding structures and property line
- 7) Location of any sign posts, fire hydrants, utility poles, etc..., in the direct vicinity of the proposed driveway *There is a pole 5 Feet from the driveway which does not interfere with the driveway*

The undersigned respectfully request that a driveway for residential use may be constructed and agrees to deposit with the City Treasurer the sum of seventy five (\$75.00) dollars, subject to the following conditions:

- a) If the application is disapproved, the deposit will be returned to the applicant;
- b) If the application is approved, construction of the driveway will not commence until such time as the full amount of the driveway construction cost as estimated by the Department of Public Works, less the \$75 deposit, is paid to the Department of Public Works by a check made out to the "City of Cambridge." Checks should be sent to the Commissioner of Public Works or to the Superintendent of Streets.
