WHEREAS: On May 20th, the Cambridge Rindge and Latin School Band, Orchestra and Jazz Ensemble, under the direction of Bob Ponte of the Cambridge Public Schools Music Department, travelled to Agawam, Massachusetts to participate in the "Great East Music Festival;" and

WHEREAS: The Great East Music Festival is an adjudicated festival, which has been in existence for over 15 years and regularly draws schools from nine northeastern states and eastern Canada; and

WHEREAS: Over forty ensembles participated in this year's competition; and

WHEREAS: Only five gold medals were awarded; and

WHEREAS: Two of these gold medals went to CRLS, one to the Orchestra and the other to the Jazz Ensemble, with a silver medal to the CRLS Band; and

WHEREAS: The CRLS Ensembles have over the years provided enjoyment, entertainment and pride to many in the City; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record congratulating the Cambridge Rindge and Latin School Band, Orchestra and Jazz Ensemble on the occasion of their receiving two gold medals and one silver medal at the Great East Music Festival; and be it further

RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the CRLS Band, Orchestra and Jazz Ensemble, and Director Bob Ponte of the Cambridge Public Schools Music Department as a sign of this City Council's, support, pride and gratitude.
